Fall has arrived and all our skating programs are now up and running. Canskaters/Parent & Tot have all been assigned to their appropriate groups, PSG (power skating) is underway, and Starskaters have been working hard at their Star 1 & 2 levels in preparation for the first events of the season.

Four of our Star 1 & 2 skaters made their way to Kelowna Sept 28, 2024, to participate in a Learn to Train Seminar. These skaters had the privilege of skating alongside four-time Canadian National Champion and Olympic Winter Games Silver Medalist, Kirsten Moore-Towers. The day was filled with on and off-ice activities, creativity, strength training and basic skating skills. Coach Cindy also attended this seminar and participated in the singles seminar training portion and took away some valuable lessons, tips and tricks to further our skaters when they reach a Star 5 and higher level of skating.

Oct. 3 included a trip to Chilliwack for four of our skaters who competed at the Autumn Leaves Competition. Of course, there is always room for improvement, but our skaters were an excellent representation of our club, at the Star 2 level, with enthusiasm and near flawless performances.

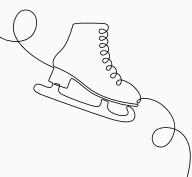

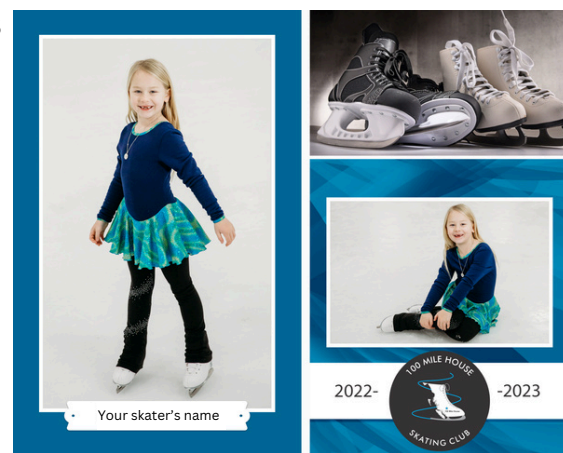


PHOTOS WITH MANDY MCLELLAND PHOTOGRAPHY:

SAFETY INFORMATION & REMINDERS:

Helmets: It is mandatory for Parent & Tot/CanSkate participants to wear a helmet that is CSA approved. (Please note that bike helmets and non-CSA approved ski or snowboard helmets are not permitted.)

Stay in the Rink! A gentle reminder for parents of Parent & Tot/CanSkate participants to remain in the rink in case your skater needs help or in the rare event of an emergency.

Rinkside Reminders: Parents/Caregivers are encouraged to watch lessons from the stands rather than the ice entrances. This helps keep the entrances clear and safe, minimizing distractions for our skaters. If your skater needs assistance, the coaches will signal you. Please refrain from stepping onto the ice in regular footwear. For any issues please reach out to the Coach, Parent/Coach Liaison, or Executive members. Kindly avoid addressing the Program Assistant(s).

Elvis Stojko & Gladys Orozco Seminar

On September 28 four of our Starskaters went to Mission, BC to attend a seminar hosted by the Mission Skating Club, which allowed them to train with Elvis Stojko and Gladys Orozco. The seminar included both on-ice and off-ice training, along with a Q&A session with the famous skaters.

Elvis' achievements include winning two Olympic silver medals, three World Championships, and seven Canadian National Championships. Stojko was the first to ever land a quadruple toe-triple toe loop combination in competition.

Gladys is a professional show skater, choreographer, coach and model. At age 12, she was the youngest competitor on the Mexican National Team. She represented Mexico for 10 years on the international competitive circuit and was selected to compete in the 2002 World Figure Skating Championships in Nagano, Japan. She holds two junior and two senior national titles. Gladys was also a principal performer with Disney on Ice and other global performing companies, allowing her to perform all over the world.

Gladys and her husband Elvis Stojko teach seminars all over Canada and Mexico. Elvis is also currently touring with Stars on Ice.

Paper order forms need to be handed into the club by October 24. Online orders can be submitted until October 25 Coffee will arrive during the first week of November and can be picked up during lessons.

Please remember that fundraising is essential to keep our club running! Fundraising helps with ice rental costs and allows for our skaters to put on ice shows. For every bag of coffee sold \$5 will go directly to our club! We ask that each skater try to sell a minimum of 5 bags each.
